FEES, TERMS AND CONDITIONS

At grass £7.00 per day + v.a.t.
Stabled £20.00 per day + v.a.t.
Foaling £300 straight fee + v.a.t.

All mares are left at Langaller Farm at their owner's risk.

All mares will be wormed and have their feet trimmed/shod when the farm deems it necessary, and owners will be charged accordingly

Any veterinary advice sought and/or medicines prescribed to visiting mares and foals will be at the owners cost. All foals born at Langaller will receive a veterinary visit within the first 24 hours and an I.G.G. test taken and a Rotavirus vaccination administered. Owners will be charged accordingly.

All stallions stand on No Foal, Free Return terms {on conception} and stud fees and keep bills must be paid in full on removal from the farm. Stud fees for A.I. to be paid in full before the semen is despatched including the collection fee.

Hind shoes must be removed before arriving at the farm or will be removed at their owners cost.

All mares must have clear C.E.M. and endrometrical swabs before covering. Endrometrical swabs will be done at the farm and owners charged accordingly.

We recommend that all visiting mares are wormed and have up to date flu, tetanus and EVA Vaccinations before arrival at the farm.

Whilst every care and attention will be given to your mare throughout her stay at Langaller Farm we accept no responsibility for any loss or damage caused to or by her or her foal
